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It is my great pleasure to welcome you to the FEI Open European Endurance Championship 2011 at Florac in France. This is an outstanding location, with the wild beauty of the Cévennes National Park providing a stunningly beautiful backdrop to this exciting event.

In order to satisfy the requirements for such an important competition, Lozère Endurance Equestre ran an extremely successful Test Event in 2010. The trail followed one large loop, and the competition set a record when attracting a massive 171 entries from 18 nations who battled it out over the 160km course. The trail has been improved and further refined in recent years, leading to much quicker finishing times. The average finishing speed for the 2010 fixture was an impressive 17.6 km/h.

Florac has a long link with Endurance, staging the first Continental Championship for this discipline back in 1984 just a year after the sport first became allied to the FEI.

Endurance is now the fastest-growing FEI discipline and has

experienced significant development over the past ten years. In 2009 a total of 708 international events were staged, a huge increase compared to just 93 in 1993, and it is very exciting to see it go from strength to strength.

In modern Endurance competition, the emphasis is on the horse finishing in good condition, rather than the one that finishes first, and it can take years for a partnership to develop to top level. Endurance requires extensive preparation, and key to success is the support crew who help ensure the health and well-being of both horse and rider during competition. This is a truly "team" sport, and to everyone competing at these Championships, and to their dedicated support crews who play such an important role, I wish the very best of luck.

On behalf of the Fédération Equestre Internationale I also extend my best wishes to the organisers, sponsors, officials, veterinary experts, horse owners, supporters, volunteers and spectators for an enjoyable and memorable event conducted in a spirit of true sportsmanship.

Images of the past History of the Florac race

In 1975, the equestrian raid "160 Km de Florac®", the Parc National des Cévennes has initiated the first real endurance competition on horseback that took place in France.

35 years after its first edition, it became one of the big "classicals" of the discipline, but also a real myth...

An emblematic race every endurance rider dreams of winning one day. The myth of the "160 Km de Florac®" was built on the difficulties of the race: important height differences, extreme temperatures, the length of the race, but also its beauty, its grandeur, the diversity of the landscapes and the crossed places, situated mostly in the center of the Parc National des Cévennes.

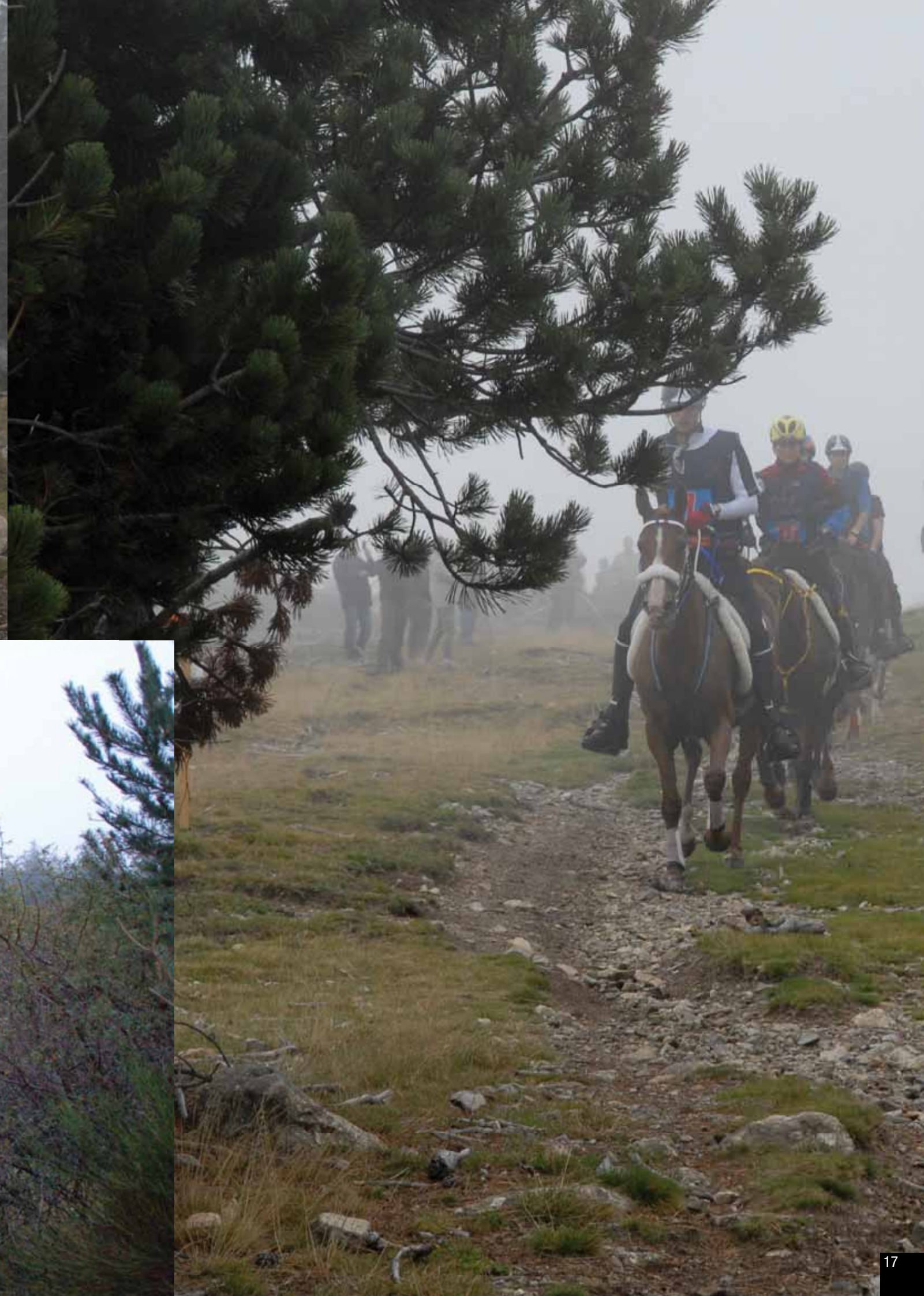
